- As a member of GACHE 4-H, I agree to conduct myself in ways that honor God and others in speech, conduct, and outward expressions. I agree to model desirable social behaviors and to guide my children in following the GACHE 4-H model of Biblical standards.
- I will respect the beliefs and scriptural truths with which GACHE 4-H was founded, and I agree to abide by their policies and requirements. I will be responsible for my children and expect them to respect and abide by GACHE 4-H's policies and requirements as well.
- I will look for opportunities to advance GACHE 4-H, help others, and encourage others with kind words, and expect my children to do the same.
- I will teach my children to be a blessing to their classmates, teachers, and surroundings and not be a distraction by being discourteous, late, or ill mannered.
- I will teach my children to respect the facility and leave it cleaner than we found it.
- I will teach my children to obey all adults present and not argue with any adult.
- I will be respectful of any Scriptural teachings and prayers led by the teachers and will expect my children to do the same.
- Students are expected to display a good attitude, respect and courtesy to all adults at GACHE functions. I will teach my children to respect all adults and students.
- Possession of drugs, alcohol, tobacco and/or any type of electronic nicotine delivery system or weapons is prohibited at all GACHE functions.
- Fighting is not allowed.
- Children should be supervised at all times.
- Conflicts should be handled in a mature, Biblical manner. Problems should be taken directly and privately to the concerned individual(s) and not become an object of gossip.
- Communication: All co-op members are expected to communicate with students, visitors, parents, teachers, and co-op leadership personnel with kindness and respect becoming a follower of Christ. Name-calling, bullying, yelling, slander, rude gestures, and gossip both in written and verbal forms will not be tolerated and may result in disciplinary action and/or dismissal from co-op entirely without reimbursement.
