1 Corinthians 6:19-20

Do you not know that your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; ²⁰ you were bought at a price. Therefore honor God with your bodies.

I will model modest dress and hold my children responsible to do likewise.

- No obscene, graphic, scary, explicit, or offensive images on any form of clothing.
- No camisole or tank tops worn alone. They must be covered by an appropriate shirt.
- No strapless shirts, leotards, unitards, bathing suits, or see-through clothing are allowed
- You may wear shorts or skirts as long as they are one inch above the knee or longer.
- Leggings may be worn as a substitute for pants.
- You may wear leggings under shorts or skirts.
- Any rips in distressed jeans or shorts should also fall at an inch or below the knee, or be lined.
- Dresses and skirts need to be an inch above the knee or longer. If they are shorter than the appropriate length they should be worn with leggings or shorts that are at least knee length.
- No bare midriffs. Tank tops and camisoles should be worn under fashionably short blouses.
- No under clothing showing... underwear/boxers/bras.
- Shirts may not be low cut nor have "spaghetti straps."
- No clothing may sag or expose undergarments.

Swim Attire

- No bare midriffs
- No exposed cleavage
- No underwear showing
- No thong style bottoms

Dress attire will depend on the event, with some events requiring costumes or period dress. In all circumstances, the general dress code will apply unless otherwise specified as in the case of prom dresses.
